Passports – doctors prefer not to undertake – discuss with GP first

Power of attorney assessment fee £100 (£150 if home visit required)

Why do GPs charge fees? Isn't the NHS supposed to be free?

The NHS provides most health care to most people free of charge. Some work is not covered by the NHS and so a fee is charged to cover the costs of providing this additional service, which includes health care professional time and administrative costs.

I only need a doctor's signature – what is the problem?

When a doctor signs a medical certificate or completes a report or letter, it is a requirement of the General Medical Council that they only sign what they know to be medically and factually correct. To complete even the simplest of forms, the doctor will have to check the patient record. Please note that the doctor is under no obligation to complete any forms and so on rare occasions, requests may be declined.
