

Patient Travel Information

Mowbray Group can provide travel advice and NHS travel vaccinations to our registered patients.

The Admin team will contact you to book a face to face travel appointment where recommendations and vaccinations for your destination will be discussed. Some vaccination courses can take 3 months to complete.

Not all vaccinations required for travel are available on the NHS. If you require a vaccination that is not available on the NHS you will need to source this via a Private Travel Clinic, these can be found at the bottom of the page.
